Diapers are not covered by social welfare or federal assistance programs, but are listed as 'hygiene items' - not essentials. 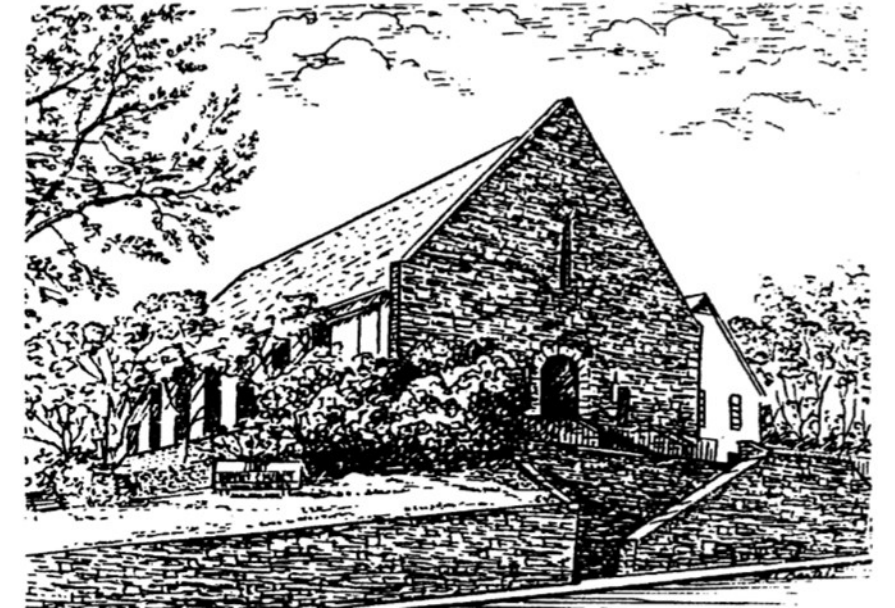
