Save the date! The Heck-Jones luncheon, sponsored by Sisterhood and the WMU, is in the Activity Building on February 5, after worship.

Heck-Jones® **Offering.** Fannie Heck served twenty-nine years as president of WMU NC until her death in 1915. During that tenure, she also served for fifteen years as the National WMU President. At Miss Heck's death, Sallie Bailey Jones became President, serving from 1915 to1935.

In 1924, nine years after Miss Fannie Heck's death, the Executive Board of WMU NC established the "Heck Memorial Offering" in her memory. Funds raised through the years supported the mission work of WMU Nc. In 1947, the name of the offering was changed to the Heck-Jones® Memorial Offering, in honor of Fannie and Sallie. Little did these two young women realize in 1886 that their dedication and service would begin a lifetime of missions work accomplished through WMU NC.


